Mr. Patrick moved to approve the minutes from the regular meeting on February 28, 2022. Mr. Lange seconded the motion. All votes were yes, motion carried.

#### **GUESTS**

Members of the Charlestown Activity Committee were asked to attend to discuss the Memorial Day Parade. Mr. Patrick had requested a fly-over that was provisionally approved based on manpower availability but would not be done on a Sunday. Discussion was held regarding changing the parade to Monday. Decision made to keep parade on Sunday. Working on speaker; Major Robinson from Camp Ravenna has been deployed. Mr. Patrick will request the Honor Guard through the Vienna Air Force Base.

### Zoning

No report.

#### Roads

Mr. Grund receiving numerous calls for pot-holes. Will wait until the weather warms up to repair. Instructed to fix pot holes on the edge of the roads with grindings donated by Mr. Patrick. Rich Hose is confirmed to work this summer.

#### Fire Department

Fire Chief Randy Porter reported the Fire Department has received 56 Fire/EMS calls, up 17 from last year.

Still working on ordering the computers; Dell representative had the wrong account information. Using Chief Porter's older personal computer at this time.

#### Fiscal Officer

Received the \$5800 check from the State Fire Marshall to reimburse for some of last year's training.

Received an email stating the \$50,000 MARCS radio grant funds have been issued; nothing has been received yet. Chief Porter to look into.

The Ohio Bureau of Worker's Compensation has adjusted our monthly premiums so the end of

year true-up payment will be less.

Ohio Auditor of State issued a memo regarding the OneOhio Opioid Settlement. 30% of the funds will go to local governments. Recommended to pass a resolution to accept the funds and to use for approved purchases.

Received email from Lisa Reeves, Portage County Regional Planning Commission, with information for application for Community Development Allocation Grant. Deadline to apply is

American Rescue Plan funds have been reallocated; Charlestown to receive an additional \$382.64.

# AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO ESTABLISH PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE YEAR 2022

The Board of Trustees of Charlestown Township, Portage County, Ohio met during a regular meeting on March 14, 2022 at the Charlestown Town hall with the following Members present:

Bruce Lange Tim Patrick

Mr. Bruce Lange moved for the adoption of the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, the Board must approve appropriations before money can be expended.

WHEREAS, it is not only required by law, but also necessary to appropriate the revenues and reserves or fund balances provided in the budget to and for the purposes described below, thereby establishing a limitation on expenditures for the operations of Charlestown Township.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Trustees of Charlestown Township, Portage County, Ohio, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The Board adopts the following permanent appropriations:

SECTION 2: That, effective March 14, 2022, the Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized, directed and approved to take all necessary steps to create temporary appropriations for tax year 2022.
