WHEREAS: The Charlestown Township Board of Trustees have identified the need to have a formal agreement to provide emergency medical services (EMS) to the residents of Charlestown Township;

WHEREAS: Due to the cost and limited resources, the Charlestown Township Fire is no able to provide EMS services 24-hours a day at this time;

WHEREAS: The City of Ravenna has submitted a contract to provide EMS services to the residents of Charlestown Township;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Charlestown Township Board of Trustees, Portage County, Ohio as follows;

SECTION 1: The board approves the Charlestown EMS Agreement (2025-2029) with the City of Ravenna, attached hereto as "Exhibit A".

CHARLESTOWN EMS AGREEMENT (2025-2029)

THIS AGREEMENT entered into this 26 day 4 and between the CITY OF RAVENNA, OHIO, hereinafter referred to as the "CITY" and CHARLESTOWN TOWNSHIP, OHIO, hereinafter referred to as the "TOWNSHIP", for purposes of contracting for the provision of emergency medical and rescue services by the CITY for the TOWNSHIP, and defining the terms and conditions for providing those services.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises of the parties herein, it is mutually agreed as follows:

- 1. The CITY shall answer calls concerning rescue and emergency medical services for related incidents as received from any person in those portions of Charlestown Township outside the corporate limits of the City of Ravenna, Ohio. In responding to such incidents, the CITY shall make use of CITY EMS/Fire Department personnel and equipment as may be necessary and available under the circumstances.
 - a. The CITY makes no warranties or guarantees as to the availability of rescue and emergency medical services to the TOWNSHIP. The CITY EMS/Fire Department equipment and personnel shall only be available if they are not presently engaged in such services at the time of the call. It is understood by the parties hereto that the CITY cannot guarantee service to be dispatched to TOWNSHIP as a result of an emergency call.
- 2. This Agreement for the rescue and emergency medical services for the TOWNSHIP by the CITY shall be in force January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2029. Said contract will renew automatically in one-year periods of time unless 90 days prior to a renewal period either party provides the other a written notice of termination of said contract for the following year.
- 3. During the period of this agreement, the Township shall pay the sum of \$72,000.00 annually with payments being made at the rate of \$18,000 quarterly for the year 2025. For 2026 to 2029, the rate shall be \$21,000 per quarter for the sum of \$84,000 annually.
- 4. The CITY will be responsible for personal injury and damage to its personnel and equipment, while going to or from and while responding to the TOWNSHIP and shall save said TOWNSHIP free and harmless from any liability by virtue thereof.
- 5. The CITY shall be an independent contractor servicing the TOWNSHIP, and as such, pay for CITY personnel withholding and any other taxes, retirement, insurance plans, unemployment compensation, and workers' compensation as may be required by law, but not limited thereto.
- 6. NOTIFICATIONS AND REPORTS
