Fire Department

Fire Chief Randy Porter reported the Fire Department has received 133 Fire/EMS calls, down 18 from last year.

Mr. Patrick and Mr. Bruce Lange inspected all township culverts – 9 need minor repairs; need to replace culvert on Vair road.

Mr. Patrick made a motion to hire Kreg Hudson to work on the culverts and to remove the cemetery fencing with his oversight; it was seconded by Mr. Eskridge and passed. Spoke to Bill at Coia's; doesn't think we should buy forks for Kubota because it isn't big enough; starter is in and transmission is in.

Mr. Bruce Lange reports the cemetery looks good after first mowing. Final quote is \$300/week for mowing and \$250/every 2 weeks for trimming.

Esworthy Road bridge was hit by a car on Saturday; county bridge engineer evaluated damage today; mostly just guard rail damage; will repair this week. Engineer will be assessing all steel bridges and rate them; will be gathering information on fire truck weights and specifics; Informed the Esworthy bridge is scheduled for repair in 2025.

Mr. Adam Eskridge reports the east cemetery drive may need some gravel or graded. EPA was at Crest Rubber but have heard any feedback.

Asked if we need to increase cemetery fees; usually reviewed at the reorganizational meeting; need to research surrounding township fees.

Mr. Eskridge moved to pay bills. Mr. Lange seconded. All votes were yes, motion carried.
