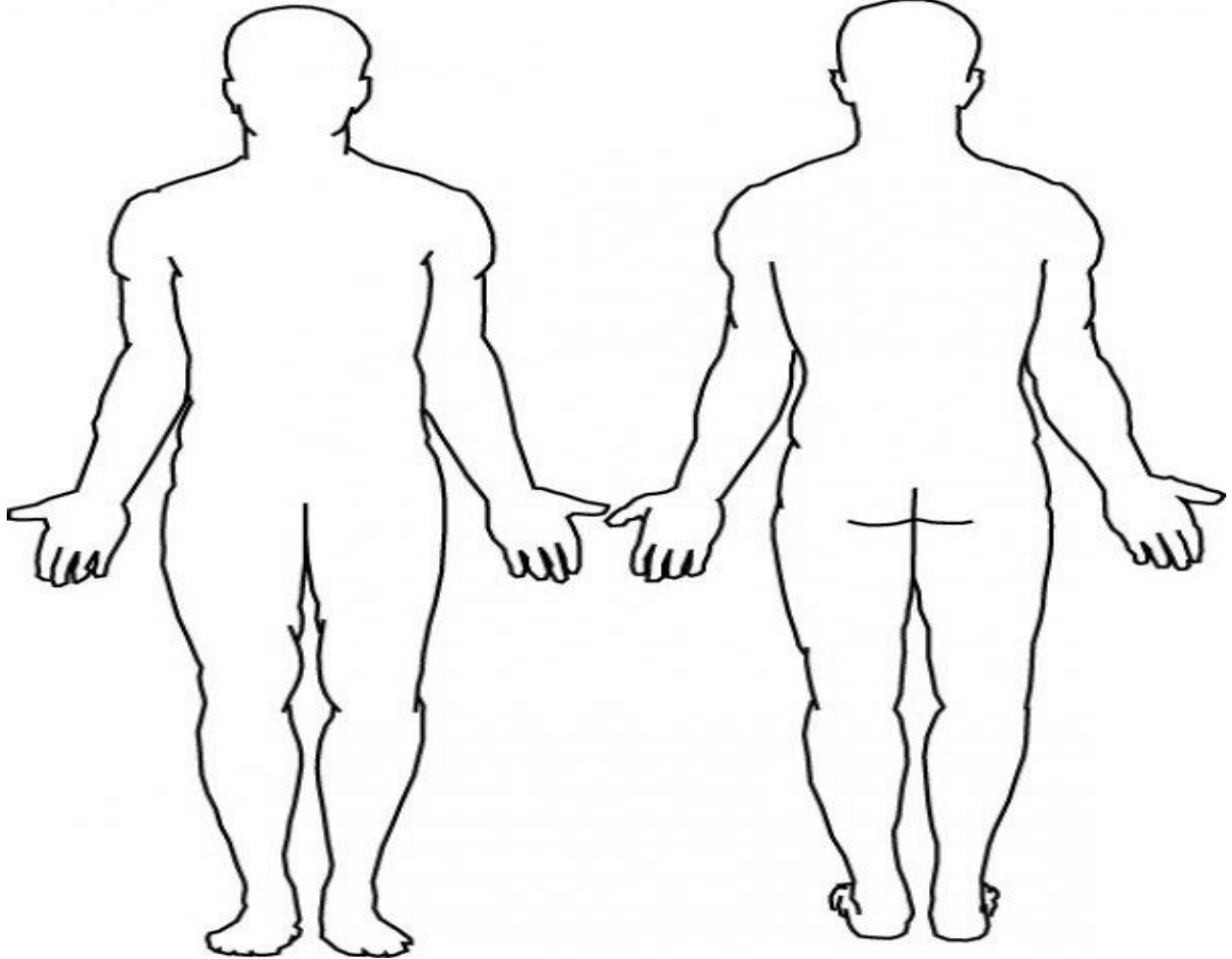

Who is most at risk?

Skin type	Details
 I	Skin colour: light, pale white, freckled (blue eye colour), likely to have light blond or red hair. Reaction to sun: always burns, never tans.
 II	Skin colour: white, peach, fair (blue, green, hazel eye colour). Reaction to sun: skin will usually burn in the sun and tans with difficulty.
 III	Skin colour: white to light brown, olive (dark blue, hazel, brown eye colour). Reaction to sun: skin will sometimes burn and will tan gradually.
 IV	Skin colour: olive, light to moderate brown (light brown eye colour). Reaction to sun: skin rarely burns and tans easily.
 V	Skin colour: brown, dark brown (dark brown eye colour). Reaction to sun: very rarely burns and tans very easily.
 VI	Skin colour: very dark brown to black (dark brown eye colour). Reaction to sun: never burns, tans very easily, deeply pigmented.
