It's coming...

In the event of an inclement weather day, please do not call the school to inquire about our status. I may not be at school to take your call. Instead, please listen to the TV or radio, or visit the Central Bucks website at www.cbsd.org to learn of school closings and delays due to inclement weather. Building Blocks does not announce by name, but follows the Central Bucks direction. If Central Bucks is **closed**, then BBLC is **closed**. (I do try my best to communicate our status via email, but just in case power is out, be aware of these alternate methods of communication.)

If Central Bucks is **delayed** two hours, our morning preschool session is **delayed** two hours as well. Arrival is 11:00 to 11:15. <u>Please give your child a hearty snack at home before coming to school...We will hold an abbreviated class session from 11:00 to 12:30, with no snack and no <u>Lunch Bunch</u>. However, if you feel the safety of the roads is compromised at any time, please feel free to keep your child at home.</u>

In case of a delay, full day Kindergarten will have delayed morning bus service, and will begin at 11:00. Dismissal is the usual 3:00. PM Kindergarten Enrichment will be unaffected.

• Please remember that it is safest for your child to enter our arrival door with his/ her hands free, especially with the snow and ice coming. I don't want children to slip and not be able to catch themselves. Please place all items, including lunch boxes and show-n-tell items, in backpacks. If your child does not wear a coat in the car, I'd rather you hand it to me at the door, instead of your child carrying it in.

•We go outside. Even if it is cold. Of course, if the wind chill is unsafe or too-too cold, we will stay indoors for recess. Please send in coats, hats, and MITTENS labeled with names. (Band-aids are great for labeling knitted items.) We absolutely prefer MITTENS, as gloves have 10 fingers, and 10 fingers times lots of little people equals a whole lot of extra time spent bundling up. Thanks for your cooperation with this.
