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#### Spring... A Time For New Beginnings

Every year, it is our BBLC tradition to bring a chick hatching project to school. This year, the eggs will arrive the week of April 16. They will stay in an incubator under our care, and are expected to hatch the next week. We will then care for the baby chicks for a few days here at school. \*\*We are still in need of someone to take the feathery friends. Please let me know if your family, or someone you know, is interested.\*\*

In anticipation if this project, your child will be bringing home a paper chick very soon to decorate with your family and then return to school to greet the arrival of the baby chicks. Instructions for this chick decorating project will be included.

From the first day the eggs arrive, there is a buzz of excitement and enthusiasm among our students and even from the wider community that shares our building. Caring for the eggs throughout the embryonic development process provides excellent learning experiences and also an upfront and personal opportunity with nature. We will not only learn to care for the eggs and chicks, but also gain vocabulary like incubator, hatch, and brood. We read books

about chicks and chickens. We bring in math by numbering and counting the eggs and predicting which egg will hatch first.



Seeing first hand new life and all the awe and wonder it brings proves this project to be another excellent extension of our curriculum. Look for the birth announcement at the drop-off door when the eggs hatch in a few weeks and you are welcome to stop in the office to see and enjoy the new, fluffy baby chicks with your child!

#### Tuition

For most families, this is the last month for tuition, as May tuition was paid at registration. Please use the tuition envelope to pay your April tuition. The envelope will be returned to you after you pay your April tuition **if no May tuition is owed.** If May tuition is still owed, the envelope will be kept at school and sent home in time for this May payment. This envelope notes our Tax ID#, as well as your payment amounts and check numbers. **Please save this envelope carefully; you may need this envelope as your receipt for 2018 taxes.** If you are looking for a record of your early 2017 payments, last school year's envelope can serve as your receipt.

Thanks so much for your consideration in donating a pack. We use fresh cups each day for snack. We certainly go through many of these plastic (not paper, as paper are not durable enough for little grips), bathroom-sized (to fit in little hands) cups each week. # Spring Conferences...

If you have not signed up for a conference yet, please know that an email was sent to you with a link to SignUp Genius. If you need the link sent again, please let me know. This is the final reminder. If you do not arrange a conference, I will deduce that you choose not to have one. (And that is fine.)

Parents are asked to enter on this day through the "left-most front door" on Mechanics Street--these are the glass doors on the left front side of the building, to the left of the "Little Library", closest to the driveway exit. I will clearly label this door. Please be extra-prompt, as our teachers are on a tight schedule. We expect well over 100 families visiting us on Conference Day, and want to avoid any foot traffic through the church main office.

#### Vision Screening

Our annual Vision Screening is scheduled for April 11-12-13. A form will go home shortly stating the actual date your child's class will be screened. This is a service provided by the Bucks County Association for the Blind and Visually Impaired. Using this service for your child is voluntary, but highly recommended. Every year, irregularities are detected when none were suspected. Parents will be required to sign a consent form before the screening can take place. A donation to the BCAB is very appreciated, and should be attached to the consent form. Again, this service is purely optional.
