Sneakers are the safest and most comfortable footwear for our busy activities. Keep in mind that we walk steps in our facility and also play out on the mulch playground. Socks are also strongly recommended for preventing injury and keeping those cute toes safe. Please follow this request. Sandals/flip flops/crocs are simply not safe for school.

Summer Fun

If you have registered for our Summer Fun Camp program, group assignments will be sent home in folders toward the end of May. Children have been grouped with other friends from their classes; these groups may not be headed by the children's usual classroom teachers. Please be assured that every effort will be made to place your child with a teacher he/she knows either from past years, or from add-ons such as Lunch Bunch or Fun Frolics. The driveway loop will be open for Summer Fun, with drop off being at the gym door from 9:00 to 9:10. Please be extra prompt, as we will begin our fun days on time and we wouldn't want your camper to miss any of the opening activities. The Summer Fun days are June 5-6-7/12-13-14.

Kindergarten Program

The spectacular End-of-Year Kindergarten Program is scheduled for Thursday, May 31 at 10:30. The Church Street door will open at 10:15 for guests. This is the last day of Kindergarten. Children come to school at 9:00 as usual, and kindergarten families may join us for this special occasion at 10:30. This is a half day with no lunch and no noon bus service--children will go home with families after the program. Please mark this day and time on your calendars as you don't want to miss this fantastic event!

The last day for T/Th Step 1 classes is Thursday, May 24. The last day for other preschool classes is Friday, May 25. The last day for preschool Lunch Bunch is Friday, May 18. Unused punches on punch cards <u>do</u> carry over to next school year and <u>are</u> transferrable to siblings!

Next School Year

If your child is registered for school next year, you will be receiving a message the first week of August, outlining particulars for class assignment and orientation. If you need to reach the school over the summer, please call the school phone number, or e-mail office@bblcinc.com. Messages are checked often. Mail is also gathered on a regular basis, so you can communicate with school via mail, phone, and email. If you would like to speak with me in person, I will be in the office from time to time, but please arrange an appointment with me.

Please be reminded that if your child is enrolled in Step 2 for the Fall, he/she must be INDEPENDENTLY potty trained.

Next school year, if your child has a food allergy/sensitivity of any kind, you will be asked to supply snack daily for your child. Packaging terms such as "made in the same facility", "shared equipment", and "may contain traces" are getting more and more common and may/may not be safe for individual children. This makes the school shopping simply too complex. We want to ensure that allergic children are eating snacks that are safe and if they are supplied by you, this adds yet another level of protection.

We are always striving to ensure the best school experience for our students. Some news about Add-ons for the 2018-2019 school year (Step 2 and PreK):

- "Mindful Mondays" --Yoga and Mindfulness one Monday a month--replacing Charming Champions
- "Fun Frolics" will remain on Wednesdays (4 weeks per session). We'll offer two dance cycles, two kid fitness cycles, an Edible Art cycle, and of course, ZUMBA!
- New "Groovy Guests" program where we invite guests to entertain, educate, and wow our students a few Fridays throughout the year (replacing Tales n' Treasures)
