December is quickly approaching and we again clearly ask our school population for extreme caution and consideration when sending your children to school. We will welcome students back on Wednesday, 12/2. For the benefit of all, please adhere to all requirements regarding health, travel, and general COVID precautions. Now is not the time to take chances......please keep your children home a few extra days if you have taken any Thanksgiving celebratory risks including gathering with folks outside of your household...if you have traveled outside of PA, a negative test result or 14-day quarantine is required before returning to school...sick children should be kept home. Thank you for your cooperation and transparency. We are all relying on each other to make smart and safe decisions.

Snow, Ice, and Sleet...Oh, my!

In the event of an inclement weather day, please do not call the school to inquire about our status. Instead, please listen to the TV or radio, or visit the Central Bucks website at www.cbsd.org to learn of school closings and delays due to inclement weather. Building Blocks does not announce by name, but follows the Central Bucks direction. If Central Bucks is **closed**, then BBLC is **closed**. (I will do my best to communicate our status via email and REMIND, but just in case power is out, be aware of these alternate methods of communication.) Please remember that it is not the normal policy of BBLC to make up any missed school time due to inclement weather.

If Central Bucks is **delayed** two hours, our morning preschool session is **delayed** two hours as well. Arrival is 11:00 to 11:15. Please give your child a hearty snack at home before coming to school...We will hold an abbreviated morning class preschool session from **11:00 to 12:30**, with <u>no snack</u>. The afternoon Pre-K class will be held from **1:30 to 3:00**, with <u>no snack</u>. However, if you feel the safety of the roads is compromised at any time, please feel free to keep your child at home. We respect your decision.



In case of a delay, full day Kindergarten will have delayed morning bus service, and will begin at 11:00. Buses will arrive to stops 2 hours later than usual. Dismissal is the regular 3:05. Lunches are needed.

Registration for the 2021-2022 school year...



An optional Drive-Thru Registration, for full day Kindergarten ONLY, will be held from 8am to 9am on Tuesday, December 1 (no classes for students this day). All other registration forms can be sent in folders, starting on Wednesday, 12/2. Info sheets, along with registration forms, came home previously for your review. Please let me know if you are in need of any additional forms and remember that only the \$80 Registration Fee (cash or check) is due at time of registration for returning families. The May 2022 tuition deposit can be deferred to

March 1. (If you elect to defer the May deposit, I have decided to bill that fee electronically--saves me trips to the bank.) You are guaranteed a preschool seat for your child, as long as registration forms are submitted in December.

In the spirit of safety, I am changing our "return to school" date from Monday, January 4 (as stated on the school calendar) to **Thursday, January 7**. Please mark your calendars. This gives us more days away from school after any New Year's get-togethers. Those three extra days will be made up in June. Our amended Winter Break will take place from December 23 to January 6. School resumes 1/7.

Reminders:

- If your child is unable to put on gloves independently, then we absolutely prefer that you send in MITTENS, as gloves have 10 fingers. 10 fingers times lots of little people equals a whole lot of extra time spent bundling up. MITTENS are our friends...
- All outerwear including hats, coats. and mittens need NAME LABELS.
- Please remember to wash your child's mask <u>after each school day</u> and his/her backpack and coat regularly.
- Our classroom windows remain open--please be sure your child has an extra zip-up sweatshirt in the backpack each and every school day.
- With the new PA Travel advisory affecting ALL TRAVEL OUTSIDE OF PA, I have added a third question to arrival safety screening. The questions are now: Any symptoms? Any exposure? **Any travel?** Bus riders are asked to self-monitor for these same questions before leaving for the bus stop.
