If a one- or a two-hour delay is called, then we will offer an abbreviated preschool session from 10:00/11:00 to 12:30 (Steps 1&2) or 12:45 (PreK), with no walk-in Lunch Bunch. Kindergarten families will receive separate instructions.

In the event of inclement weather, please do not call the school to inquire about our status. Check for an early morning or "night before" text from REMIND or an email from the school office with information about our status. Of course, if you feel the safety of the roads is compromised, we respect your decision to keep your child at home.
