- Be sure to change out sets of extra clothing in backpacks to weather-appropriate items.
- **MITTENS** are highly preferred over gloves (so much easier for us to get on than gloves with fingers)! Band-aids or medical tape for name labels inside mittens and hats work well.
- Over-the-Head style jackets are an obstacle for us at school. We like to encourage independence, and this style can be just too difficult to manage. Please choose outerwear for school that opens down the front.
- We will again be hosting our traditional **Holiday Sing** this year! Step 2/PreK/Kindg students will participate in fabulous holiday shows on Friday, December 19. Up to three seated guests per student will be invited to attend. Much more info to follow.
