On the reverse side, please find the registration agreement form for the 2025-2026 school year. Registrations for currently-enrolled students are processed beginning in December, and new family registrations (or families without a currently-enrolled student) are processed beginning January 1. Classes are filled on a first-come, first-serve basis. The school will not over-enroll a class. Wait lists may be formed. **Registration payments are accepted by cash or check.** 

**NEW FAMILIES:** Enrollment is confirmed after the following paperwork is submitted:

- Completed and signed Registration Agreement Form (reverse side) plus Info/Emergency Contact Form
- Payment of May 2026 tuition deposit
- Payment of \$85 NON-REFUNDABLE registration fee per child

<u>CURRENTLY-ENROLLED FAMILIES</u> need to submit Registration Form, Info/Emergency Contact Form, and \$85 NON-REFUNDABLE registration fee per child. May 2026 tuition deposit is due by March 1, 2025. Seats will not be formally confirmed until May 2026 deposit is received. If deposit is not received by the due date, the seat may need to be forfeited to an awaiting family.

**FAMILY DISCOUNT**: Families with two or more children concurrently enrolled at BBLC should deduct 10% from the younger siblings' monthly tuitions--to the nearest dollar. First child is full price.

## **CLASS DESCRIPTIONS:**

**Step One--** For children turning three by about January 31, 2026. This class is designed to be a child's first school experience. Time at school is gradually added, allowing children to acclimate to the group setting. The classes are small, exposing children to stories, songs, fingerplays, art media, and fine/gross motor skill activities. The emphasis includes an introduction to academic/social skills and good school habit development. Letters, numbers, and age-appropriate themes are gently presented. Children are **not required** to be potty trained for this class.

<u>Step Two</u>--For three-year-olds who turn four by August 31, 2026. Exposure to numbers and letters is emphasized, as well as appropriate social interactions. Good school habits are reinforced, and small motor skills are sharpened. Name writing is introduced and practiced. Daily activities include art, music, stories, and play. Children must be **independently** potty trained for this and all older programs; no diapers or pull ups permitted.

<u>3-Day Pre-K</u>--For four-year-olds who turn five by August 31, 2026. This program is aimed at developing full Kindergarten readiness. Letter and number formation and recognition are practiced, along with phonics. Math concepts including counting, number sense, and estimation are covered. Fun with art, music, and play are included in this program, as well as fine and gross motor skill activities. Social awareness is further developed and strengthened.

<u>5-Day Pre-K</u>--For four-year-olds who turn five by August 31, 2026, or for the child in need of another year of preschool before entering Kindergarten. This program covers the kindergarten readiness curriculum of the 3-Day Pre-K, with additional class time for added skill practice and emphasis on the social sciences, cooking, Scholastic News, science experiments, etc.

<u>Kindergarten--</u> Our full day program solidly prepares students for first grade. Pre-reading, reading, and literacy skills, including phonics, are taught using a variety of strategies. Math skills include number sense, operations, time, and money. Public speaking is practiced, and children also enjoy fine and gross motor play, creative expression, Spanish, Music, and science/social studies exploration. Central Bucks residents may be eligible for district transportation. Half day options or afternoon enrichment (a companion to AM public school programs), may be available <u>only if space permits--enrollment</u> will begin in July.

Transportation for students will be provided by parents (or CB buses for Kndg). Medical care, if required, will be paid for by the parents. Our Parent Handbook outlining all policies can be found on our website BuildingBlocksPA.com. Child's Immunization Record is required.
