We are a local, independent, non-profit organization that is not affiliated with any other SPCA or humane society, including the ASPCA. All donations to the Sacramento SPCA go to help the animals right here in our community. Financial support for our programs and services is provided solely by donations from individuals, businesses, and foundations. Through our nationally-ranked low-cost high-volume spay and neuter clinic (we are ranked as one of the top 10 clinics in the country!), adoption program, vaccine clinics and more, the Sacramento SPCA - with our community's support - is giving more than shelter and saving animals one life at a time.

Two of the lives recently saved were "The Princesses." Yes, two Pomeranians both named Princess were surrendered to the Sacramento SPCA when their original owner abandoned them. After a name addition to tell them apart, Peach and Daisy received "senior specials" (dentals and blood work) at our Zoe K. McCrea Animal Health Center, in addition to the standard vaccinations and microchips. During their medical evaluations, we also found that Daisy had masses on and around her kidneys - meaning her time may be short. But since she was happy and otherwise enjoying life, she qualified for our Pawspice program where the Sacramento






SPCA supports the animal and adopter by providing palliative care to an animal with a terminal illness. After we discovered that despite living together for 11 years, Peach and Daisy actually did not enjoy each other's company, they each found wonderful families to love them through their golden years.

We depend on the community's support to house, feed, heal and place the thousands of animals like Peach and Daisy. In addition, we have designated funds which provide support for specific animal needs, like our Paws for Health fund to care for animals requiring specialized veterinary care; the Feline Spay and Neuter Fund, which provides additional spay/neuter surgeries for free-roaming cats Monday - Saturday; and The Joe Willie Initiatives which provides senior cats and those requiring extra medical attention second chances. We also host several events throughout the year that support our work, including the Doggy Dash.





SACRAMENTO

The Doggy Dash is Northern California's largest 2K/5K dog walk and pet festival. Now in its 31st year, this event brings together animal lovers to raise funds for the Sacramento SPCA's lifesaving programs. Participants can enjoy food, drinks, games, demos, prizes, and the opportunity to meet adoptable dogs. Registration and participation in the Doggy Dash help provide direct care to over 40,000 animals in the community each year.

"The Doggy Dash offers a unique opportunity to have fun with your dog and it also connects people and animals to the resources needed to support healthy relationships," said Dawn Foster, Sacramento SPCA Marketing & Communications Director. "Enjoying time with your canine companion while also helping our community's pets in need is a win-win!"



RECIPE Slow-Cooker Corned Beef and Cabbage


