I will also be making a deputation to the council for the Town of Blue Mountains this Monday morning with the same request, Clearview Township on February 12th 2024 and the Wasaga Beach Town council on February 29th, 2024. My hope is that this will be the first step from which we will continue to build on in order to create a greater sense of safety for all of us. Last Tuesday January 30th, 2024, Daniella Lurion from Friends of Simon Wiesenthal Centre (FSWC) for Holocaust Studies presented at the Collingwood Library in commemoration of International Holocaust Remembrance Day, a talk on "The Lessons and Legacies of the Holocaust". What a wonderful opportunity to take a deeper dive into the subject and to share this with our local friends and neighbours. I am looking forward to more opportunities like these as they help to remind us all of the possible outcomes of such systemic hatred and the importance and need for our communities to stand together against hate of all kinds.
