

Manufacturer's Certification Statement

Wincore Windows & Doors, located at 250 Staunton Avenue, Parkersburg, WV 26104, certifies that certain exterior windows that meet the ENERGY STAR® Most Efficient window qualifications, and exterior doors that meet ENERGY STAR® criteria for the climate zone in which they are installed may be eligible for the tax credits as set forth in the extension of the American Taxpayer Relief Act of 2013.

To qualify for the extension of the tax credit, exterior windows must be certified ENERGY STAR* Most Efficient, exterior doors must meet ENERGY STAR* criteria, and the products must be installed in your principal residence between January 1, 2023 and December 31, 2025. Homeowners may claim the maximum annual credit every year that eligible improvements are made through 2025.

Homeowners must include the 4-character Qualified Manufacturer ID (QMID) Code for 2025 window and door installations when claiming the Energy Efficient Home Improvement Credit, specifically on Form 5695.

It is also important for the homeowner to retain this certification statement as well as the purchase receipt and National Fenestration Rating Council (NFRC) label for each eligible window and door, as it may be requested by the Internal Revenue Service (IRS).
