You are not alone and are a valued team member in caring for our children. We are here to provide supports and services to help you and your family.

Family Urgent Response System (FURS)

Staff are available to assist youth and caregivers with any issue, big or small, that needs attention for placement stability (to support the caregiver and the placed youth when in crisis or needing urgent support). FURS is a neutral and judgment–free resource. In-person response is often available within 1 hour.

Caregiver Warmline

Staff can provide you with contact information for the DCFS/Probation Child Welfare (PCW) staff assigned to your case, foster care payment questions or missing payments, adoption information and recruitment, Medi-cal card issues, and Relative Support services.

Relative Support Services

The Relative Support Services (RSS) community-based agencies provide supportive services to Kin caregivers throughout Los Angeles County. RSS serves ALL Kin caregivers residing in Los Angeles County, open formal welfare case or not, including Kin caregivers associated with other counties. RSS agencies offer a wide range of supports, including (but not limited to): emergency financial support, Kin caregiver support groups, referrals to community-based supportive services, tutoring for youth in Kin care, recreation activities for caregivers and youth, legal assistance, transportation, food and housing. Kin caregivers can self-refer or be referred by any service provider associated with the family. To be referred, Kin caregiver should contact the LA County Caregiver WarmLine above.
