



Academic Support for Students in Foster Care

LACOE Foster Youth Services Coordinating Program (FYSCP) helps connect students in foster care that need additional academic support with tutoring resources.

The 2020-2021 foster youth tutoring online referral submission is currently active. Please submit all online referrals through our FYS tutoring site (see reverse side for instructions). Students will receive **up to 20 hours** of in-home, one-on-one tutoring each school year.

Required Information

Before you begin, the following information is required to submit a tutoring referral:

- Court Status Foster, Open Juvenile Dependency (WIC 300), Probation Open Delinquency (WIC 602), Both Dual Supervision, or Non-Minor Dependent
- Caregiver Contact Information
- LA County Department of Children and Family Services office name and CSW (Children's Social Worker) and/or LA County Probation PO (Probation Officer) information
- Placement Type and if applicable, group home or foster family agency name
- Student Information (name, birth date, gender, grade level and courses)

Not having the required or correct information may delay the processing of your referral.
