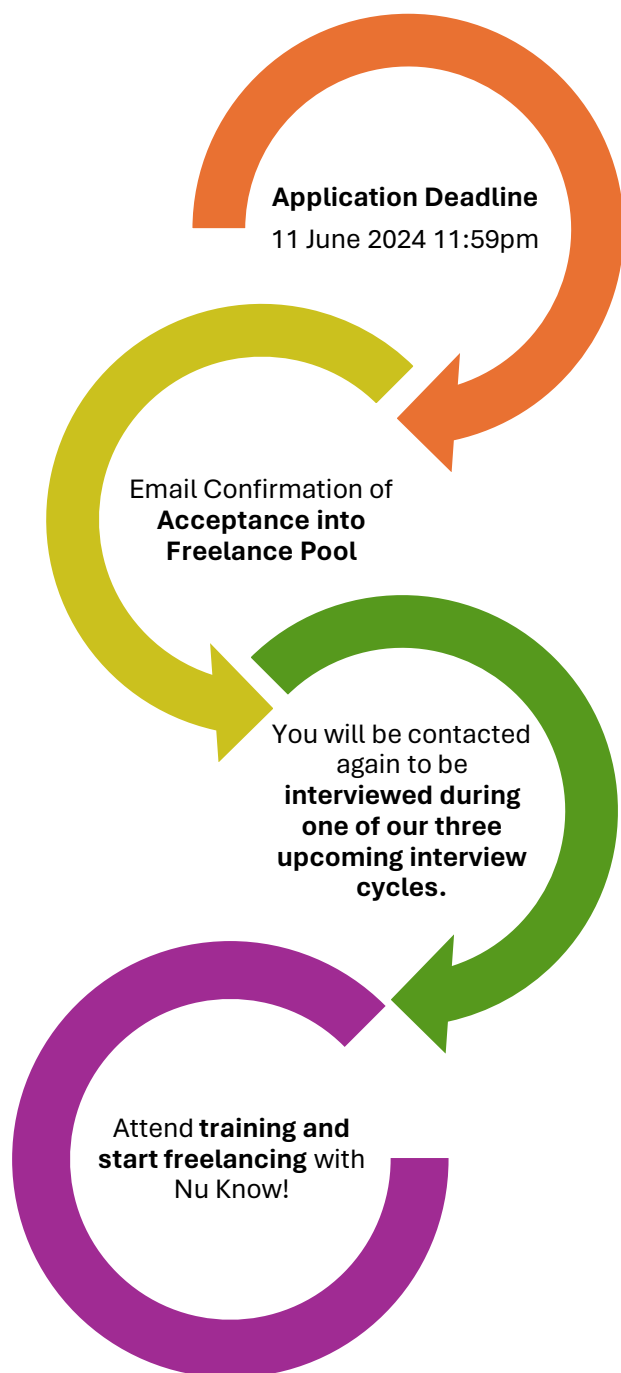
- A demonstrated passion for the well-being, safety, and development of youth (aged 8-19)
