# 2) It is recommended that the Board of Trustees approve Personnel Report 2

\*Government Code section 1090 prohibits public officials, including school board members, from being "financially interested in any contract made by them in their official capacity, or by any body or board of which they are members." Similar to Section 1090, the Political Reform Act prohibits public officials from "mak[ing], participat[ing] in making or in any way attempt[ing] to use his official position to influence a governmental decision in which he knows or has reason to know he has a financial interest." (Cal. Gov. Code § 87100). Under the PRA, an impermissible "financial interest" can include those which have a reasonably foreseeable "material financial effect" on the official's immediate family. (Cal. Gov. Code § 87103). "Immediate family" is defined as spouse or dependent children. (Cal. Gov. Code § 82029). Employing the "Rule of Necessity" allows public officials to take actions they would otherwise be disqualified from taking due to a conflict of interest if their disqualification would make it impossible to fulfill one of the board's vital public duties. (Finnegan v. Schrader, 91 Cal. App. 4th 572, 582), with respect to the current state of the five member board with two vacancies.
