It is time to Register for Transitional Kindergarten and Kindergarten

Enrollment is open for Transitional Kindergarten and Kindergarten for 2022-2023. Enrollment packets are available online at helus.org or packets may be picked up at the school office 8:00-3:00 M-F. The age requirements are changing. Below is a chart on the age changes and phase-in of Universal Pre Kindergarten.

Phase in of UPK	2022-23	2023-24	2024-25	2025-26
Age Eligibility	Children who turn five between September 2 and February 2 may enroll	Children who turn five between September 2 and April 2 may enroll	Children who turn five between September 2 and June 2 may enroll	Turn four by September 1 may enroll
