This virtual series of events takes place Wednesday afternoons, with the next session on January 20; programs are offered in English at 4:00 pm and in Spanish at 5:00 pm. Events are held on Webex, allowing presenters to interact with parents and caregivers, and address questions and concerns in real time.
