**Receive \$246 per child:** The Families First Coronavirus Response Act allows meal replacement benefits for households with children who attend a school that is closed and who otherwise would have received free or reduced price meals. The program has been extended. Families who received \$246. per child March - June will soon receive \$246 per child per month for August, September, and October. This is for families who have already applied for free and reduced meals. In addition to the cash support, families may also participate in the daily lunch and breakfast meals provided through HELUS drive through. Any and all families with children under 18 may participate in the free daily lunch and breakfast drive through program. If you have not applied, please do so ASAP at **avfood.org** or

### **RETURN STUDENTS TO CAMPUS STATUS**

LA County remains at the purple level on California's Blueprint for a Safer Economy. Therefore, schools may not fully reopen. You may be hearing about some schools bringing special populations with restrictions back on campus. HELUS does not fit any of the eligible areas currently allowed. HELUS's current Board Resolution for school closure is through the end of the first semester, January 29. The *Return Students To Campus Committee* meets weekly in workgroups or meets as an entire committee to work on HELUS' plan and to discuss health order updates. The committee consists of representatives from each of the following stakeholder groups: Teachers, Classified Staff, School Site Council, School Board, Administration/Management, and Parents. 
