#### GEWC MANAGERS REPORT – July 17, 2024

#### City Relations/Facility Update

Facility has been busy with user groups. As of July  $9^{th}$ , ball hockey completed their season, boards came out July  $11/12^{th}$ .

- BC Summer Games is in facility from July 15-22<sup>nd</sup>.
- Country Fest is in facility from July 23-29<sup>th</sup>.
- City is using the facility for a ball hockey camp Aug 6-9<sup>th</sup>.
- Cornhole Nationals using facility Aug 13-18<sup>th</sup>.

Club will get dry floor back on Aug 19<sup>th</sup>, refrigeration will go on August 22<sup>nd</sup>. Ice will be ready for September 6<sup>th</sup>. League play will commence September 9<sup>th</sup>

#### City payments

Received April and May payments from the city for ball hockey/rentals/operating agreement \$ 28,503.38 was electronically deposited into our account.

Still outstanding are June and July payments – Shannon to continue to follow up on when we will expect payment.

Cornhole Nationals – Aug 13-18th

A volunteer crew needs to be established for this event. <u>Action</u> - Shannon and Jason to discuss further what the expectations are based on past meetings with this user group.

#### **GEWC Volunteer Program**

Shannon and Corey Hodges met to debrief the program. Corey is willing to help an additional season with getting the Sign-Up.com site up and running with all the tasks etc.

#### Overview of program:

We had 66% of our membership participate in the program last season.

Overall, it was successful, still need more involvement when it comes to bonspiels and on ice rentals.

We need to better educate our membership on how to use the signup.com platform, a short instructional email will be sent to the members to give them more ease in how to use the system.

<u>Action -</u> Board to determine what the fee and hourly commitment will be for the program this upcoming season.

#### Registration and Events

Shannon working on Curling I/O pages to roll out the registration for the 2024/25 Season. Board agreed on a 10% fee increase for the upcoming season.

Recommend a small group be established to discuss the Junior Program and Learn to Curl Program. (Both programs require a volunteer base to run). How can we compensate these volunteers that commit time to these programs on a weekly basis during the course of the entire season. Can an honorarium be established? Note – our Jr. program is one of the cheapest in the Lower Mainland.
