City Relations/Facility Update

Murray Davvison (Electrician and member of our club) continues to work on improving our electrical in the upper lounge, we have two new circuits in place near the pool table. Murray also moved some track lighting for the dart boards. Next step is electrical near the bar.

City is replacing the burnt-out lamp standards in the east parking lot.

Mirror in Men's washroom had to be replaced as the old one cracked when trying to remove the broken soap dispenser.

Dehumidifier occasionally times itself out, Dean continues to monitor it on a regular basis. No action at this time.

Back ice (shorter sheets) fully painted this season. We have had Discover Curling School groups accessing it already. This is the first time we have painted it post-Covid, it's been well received by the members and participants thus far.

Overhead camera project

Beginners/Novice League (Starts Oct 5^h) - Registration still coming in.

40 registered curlers, last season we had 61. A handful have transitioned now into other leagues.

Curling Day in BC

Note - Already have a club rental that afternoon from 1-5pm. Do we want to do something that day? In the morning? Junior Curling is scheduled for that day...

As the meeting was postponed one week, it was too late to put anything in place for this.

Ann-Marie Orser is going to help with the tracking of the volunteer system. Overall, it's working well, except for rental groups and bonspiels, which still need more helpers. Very few complaints have been received by the board or management team.

4. Action items from previous meeting

- e. Discussion around tournament seating as in the King Cash; it was decided that we will borrow seats from the city or rent some (as opposed to buying same).
- f. Club strategic plan: Does Curl BC have a template? Jason will ask Lindsay. **ACTION: Jason**

We would like to set some goals by the end of the year.

- g. Curling pins that were donated: discussion ensued. Since these pins are not secured, the shadows boxes can be opened, and there is a concern regarding safety. It was suggested we reach out to Curl BC to see if they might want to showcase them somewhere. **ACTION: Shannon**
- h. The items that were removed from the walls for painting and are in storage: a committee needs to be struck to make decisions around these items, which will go up before next season begins. **ACTION: Shannon, all**
- i. The Senior Volunteer Fair was well attended; Flo and Ron Laxdale represented the club.
