A disturbing trend involving Hyundai and Kia vehicles has been recognized by the St. Louis County Auto Crime Unit. Hyundais and Kias, with push-button starts manufactured between 2010 and the early 2020's, can be quickly "hotwired" even without the presence of a key fob. We highly recommend the use of a secondary security device such as a Club.
