William Carey University is accredited by the Commission on Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools, 1866 Southern Lane, Decatur, Georgia 30033: telephone number 404-679-4501, to award bachelor, master, specialist, and doctoral degrees.

Programs accredited by their individual accrediting agencies are listed in the university catalog.

William Carey University has had four previous names. The names and dates are:

Pearl River Boarding School, 1892-1905 South Mississippi College, 1906-1910 Mississippi Woman's College, 1911-1954 William Carey College, 1954 to 2006 William Carey University, 2006 to present

The unit of credit is and has been the semester hour.

Calendar: Prior to 1976, the college used the semester calendar. Beginning Fall 1976, some branch sites of the college remained on the semester calendar and some adopted the trimester calendar. Beginning Fall 1991, all campus sites of the college adopted the trimester system.

Course numbers: Courses numbered 1 - 499 carry undergraduate credit. Courses numbered 500 and above carry graduate credit. Honors courses carry an 8 or H at the end of the course number.

Grading system: Prior to Fall 1966, quality points were awarded on a 3.0 grade scale as follows:

A = 3 points per credit hour B = 2 points per credit hour C = 1 point per credit hour D = 0 points per credit hour

Beginning Fall 1966, and to present, the following 4.0 grade scale is followed:

A = 4 points per credit hour
B = 3 points per credit hour
C = 2 points per credit hour
D = 1 point per credit hour
F = 0 points per credit hour

P = Passed-not used in computation of GPA R = Repeated-not used in computation of GPA

AU = Audit
