TRANSCRIPT EXPLANATION GUIDE

William Carey University is accredited by the Commission on Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools, 1866 Southern Lane, Decatur, Georgia 30033: telephone number 404-679-4501, to award bachelor, master, specialist, and doctoral degrees.

Programs accredited by their individual accrediting agencies are listed in the university catalog.

William Carey University has had four previous names. The names and dates are:

Pearl River Boarding School, 1892-1905
South Mississippi College, 1906-1910
Mississippi Woman's College, 1911-1954
William Carey College, 1954 to 2006
William Carey University, 2006 to present

The unit of credit is and has been the semester hour.

Calendar: Prior to 1976, the college used the semester calendar. Beginning Fall 1976, some branch sites of the college remained on the semester calendar and some adopted the trimester calendar. Beginning Fall 1991, all campus sites of the college adopted the trimester system.

Course numbers: Courses numbered 1 - 499 carry undergraduate credit. Courses numbered 500 and above carry graduate credit. Honors courses carry an 8 or H at the end of the course number.

Grading system: Prior to Fall 1966, quality points were awarded on a 3.0 grade scale as follows:

A	=	3 points per credit hour
B	=	2 points per credit hour
C	=	1 point per credit hour
D	=	0 points per credit hour

Beginning Fall 1966, and to present, the following 4.0 grade scale is followed:

A	=	4 points per credit hour
B	=	3 points per credit hour
C	=	2 points per credit hour
D	=	1 point per credit hour
F	=	0 points per credit hour
I	=	Incomplete*
P	=	Passed—not used in computation of GPA
R	=	Repeated—not used in computation of GPA
AU	=	Audit
W	=	Withdrew—not used in computation of GPA
WP	=	Withdrew passing—not used in computation of GPA
WF	=	Withdrew failing—used in computation of GPA
N	=	In progress—not used in computation of GPA
NC	=	No Credit—not used in computation of GPA
FA	=	Failure Nonattendance-no impact on GPA (FA/ENGLISH & COMPUTER PROFICIENCY EXAMS ONLY)

*Incomplete grades have no immediate impact on a student's record. "I" grades are changed to "F" if not removed by the end of the next scheduled term.

For Fall 2005, classes were voided and grades of "V" were given to students who were displaced due to natural disaster. These grades are not used in computation of GPA.

Repeat courses: William Carey University allows students to repeat courses. The last grade earned stands as the official grade.

Transfer credits: Transfer credits are shown in detail on the transcript and are computed in the overall grade point average.

The College of Osteopathic Medicine opened at William Carey University Fall 2010, with courses on the semester schedule. First year students (OMS I) and second year students (OMS II) are graded on the same scale as described previously, with grades of A, B, C, F, P, I, W, WP, and WF awarded.

Third and fourth year COM students (OMS III and OMS IV) are graded on the following scale:

- H Honors
- HP High Pass
- P Pass
- F Fail
- IP In Progress

Transcript validation: An official transcript with the printed seal and signature of the university registrar is printed on burgundy safety paper. Copies issued to students will have "Issued to Student" stamped on the transcript.
