Community Construction and Ongoing Maintenance.

Throughout the community there are several ongoing projects happening. As we prepare for two large projects in 2020, plumbing re-pipe and painting, there are buildings with wood rot damage. You may have noticed the wood siding on certain units being removed and replaced/repaired. Also units with planter boxes in the front are being

removed. This is being done for safety, water conservation and ongoing repair expence. The planters have started to deterierate and become unstable. Some from water but others from age and/or root damage. This will save the community money having them removed and avoid any safety issues should one of these collapse.



Please note we will do our best to ensure the homeowner/resident(s) are notified, however we apologize if some of these repairs have taken place without prior notice. We are working with management and our vendor on their communication throughout the community. We appreciate your patience.

In addition there is a large WM dumpster parked on the property near Cereza/Roble. This is being used for these projects and we are working to have it moved to a more convient location. The WM company confirmed it is within the size limits to be where it is but we

understand there is a safety concern from residents regarding service access and we have asked it be relocated. Thank you for your patience as we work through these large projects.
