Waste Management Update

Many of you may have noticed over the last few weeks, the HOA team has taken on the huge task of gathering some of the old trash cans throughout the community and were fortunate to arrange a large pick-up. This has been an extremely daunting task, those of you who have called WM are aware of the overwhelming delays. Any remaining cans, old or extra are homeowner responsibility. Please continue to contact WM and schedule a pickup, this can take time so please remain diligent.

When WM began this change, old trash containers were to be left out for pick up. Since that time if your old cans have not yet been removed, they must be stored away as any other trash can you currently have.

WM will no longer be coming by to pick up old cans. <u>Residents must call</u> to have this taken care of. No longer are cans allowed to be left outside garage doors, in the alley, driveway or breezeway areas.

Can I use a plastic bag? Can I use biodegradable bags?

• No plastic bags are accepted. WM prefers that you do not use any bags. If you need to mitigate odor or the "yuck" factor, recycled brown paper bags are acceptable. Please keep your cans clean and stored properly.

SoCal Edison-Street/Parking light out? Get it fixed!



Most streetlights located in and around our community are maintained by Southern California Edison (SCE). Usually identified by the pole approx. 35 feet tall, octagonal, and concrete or the streetlight is mounted on a wooden

utility pole. Also, it is a SCE streetlight if there is an identifying code number embossed on a metal plate that is mounted on the pole.
