NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY AT ANY TIME. ALL PERSONS USING THE FACILITIES WILL DO SO AT THEIR OWN RISK

- Pool safety equipment is for emergency use **ONLY**.
- Children under fourteen (14) years of age are not allowed in the pool area unless accompanied by an adult. Children not potty trained <u>MUST wear swim diapers</u>. Cloth diapers and disposable diapers ARE NOT PERMITTED.
- Proper swimwear is **required**.
- No alcoholic beverages permitted ~ No smoking or vaping of any kind.
- No furniture or equipment may be removed from the pool area or inappropriately used.

Operation Clean Street / Street Sweeping

The City of Mission Viejo sweeps our public residential streets free of charge every two weeks to keep debris from entering the storm drain and polluting our creeks, beaches, and ocean.

Sweeping is done every other week the day after trash day except for holidays, when streets are swept one day later. Remember to park your car off the street during street sweeping days.
