#### Operation Clean Street / Street Sweeping

The City of Mission Viejo sweeps our public residential streets free of charge every two weeks to keep debris from entering the storm drain and polluting our creeks, beaches, and ocean.

Sweeping is done <u>every other week the day after trash day</u> except for holidays, when streets are swept one day later. Please try to <u>park your car off the street</u> during street sweeping days. Our community will look for much cleaner!!

By moving your car, the street sweepers will be able to sweep the entire pavement, from curb to curb, and collect all the pockets of debris, oil and grease that collect underneath the cars.
