

A supernatural, unexplained force has trapped you inside the Mission Viejo Library! Can you solve the riddles and unlock a counter curse before it's too late?



Plumbing Reminder

The responsibility for maintaining many plumbing fixtures and lines remain with the condo owner, including past owner neglect, you as the current unit owner would be responsible for any damage. Blockages in common area pipes are typically the result of someone putting non-soluble particulates products in the drainage system. It is important that you take care to properly maintain your drains by not flushing inappropriate materials or allowing grease, oil, or solids into drains.

Talk to your neighbors, read the monthly HOA newsletter, and become self-educated on how to maintain your home and avoid costly repairs.

Info You Gotta Know



WATER LEAKS

Each resident has the duty to promptly report all water leaks and evidence of leaks (such as water spots on ceilings, wet walls, or floors, etc.) to the Association's management company. The Association will not be responsible for damage to a unit which results from an unreported water leak.
