Operation Clean Street / Street Sweeping

The City of Mission Viejo sweeps our public residential streets free of charge every two weeks to keep debris from entering the storm drain and polluting our

creeks, beaches, and ocean.

Remember to park your car off the street during street sweeping days. By moving your car, the street sweepers will be able to sweep the entire pavement, from curb to curb, and collect all the pockets

of debris, oil and grease that collect underneath the cars. The **Residential Street** Sweeping Map (https://cityofmissionviejo.org/sites/default/files/street-sweep-

map.pdf) shows the street sweeping areas in your neighborhood corresponding to the

day of the week. Sweeping is done every other week the day after trash day except for holidays, when streets are swept one day later.
