SoCal Edison - Street/Parking light out?

To report streetlight outages, you can call the Edison Company 24 hours a day, seven days a week. The phone number is listed on your electric bill: 800-655-4555. Streetlights can also be reported at Southern California Edison Outage Center. When calling Edison, be specific to the address or location of the inoperative light. If you can give them the utility pole identification number (it starts with E), service can be provided much faster and easier.

Please note that if a stand-alone light pole is on a private street, it remains Southern California Edison's responsibility and should be reported to them. Outdoor lights are owned and maintained by municipalities and utilities.
