FEBRUARY CLUB RUN

Leaving from the back entrance turning right onto Riverview St then left onto King St and following that road and then turn left into Bellmere Rd and then left again into River Dr which then turns into Torrens Rd and at the roundabout take the 3rd exit onto Grant rd. Follow Grant Rd down to the T junction and turn right onto Caboolture River Rd. Then after a few kms turn left onto Walkers Rd and stay on this road and then turn right onto Oakey Flat Rd. After a few kms turn left into Rowley Rd and across the railway line and then at the roundabout take the 3rd exit onto Burpengary Rd. Keep going until you reach Boundary Rd and turn right onto Boundary Rd and cross the railway line and turn left onto Narangba Rd. At the next set of lights turn right onto Torrens rd and go past Lake Kurwongbah which turns into Beeville rd and at the roundabout take the 4th exit onto Dayboro rd. At the next traffic lights turn left onto Youngs Crossing rd and then take the next turn to the right onto Protheroe rd and follow this road until you come to Bullocky's rest where we will have morning tea. Leaving Bullocky's rest turn right onto Forgan Rd and following to the T junction and turn right onto Winn rd. Follow Winn Rd until you meet another T junction and turn left onto Mt Samson rd. Stay on Mt Samford rd until you reach Samford. For those that want food/coffee the Kenilworth Samford Bakery (great donuts) is beside the Samford Hotel with Parking at the back of the hotel should you wish to stop. Travel through Samford and at the roundabout turn left onto Samford rd. Follow this road until you come to Ferny Grove and turn right into Tramway st and make your way into the Brisbane Tramway Museum. This is where we will have our lunch and for those who would like to participate there is a fee of \$15 pp to ride the trams and visit the museum and workshops.
