THAI-STYLE CHICKEN ROLLS

■ Makes 18, Prep 20 mins, Cook 30 mins

W A T Y O U N E E D

- 3 sheets frozen puff pastry, thawed
- 1 free-range egg, lightly beaten
- Sweet chilli sauce and lime wedges, to serve (optional)

FOR THE CHICKEN FILLING:

- 500g free-range chicken mince
- 1½ cups fresh breadcrumbs
- 1 free-range egg, lightly beaten
- 3 tsp red curry paste
- 1 tsp finely grated lime rind
- 1 tbsp lime juice
- 2 green spring onions, finely chopped
- ¼ cup chopped fresh coriander leaves and stems
- 1 tbsp fish sauce
- 1 tbsp sweet chilli sauce

- 1 To make filling, place all ingredients in a large bowl. Mix well. Divide evenly into six portions.
- 2 Cut pastry sheets in half. Place a portion lengthways down the centre of each pastry half. Brush one long side of pastry with egg. Roll up to enclose filling. Cut each roll into three pieces. Place on a large oven tray lined with baking paper. Brush with egg.
- 3 Cook in a hot oven (200°C) for about 25–30 minutes, or until pastry is golden brown.
- 4 Serve sausage rolls with sweet chilli sauce and lime wedges (optional).

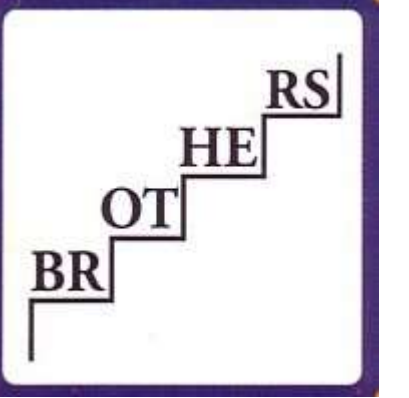
