Regarded as one of the best rainforest bushwalks north of Brisbane, Maiala is set in the beautiful surrounds of Mount Glorious. Perfect for beginners, families, or those just want to take a stroll among nature, Maiala is teeming with beautiful flora and fauna as well as educational plaques dotted along the track. Enjoy beautiful picnic areas with toilet facilities. Maiala was the first area on the D'Aguilar Range to become a national park. It now forms part of D'Aguilar National Park. In the 1860s Maiala was once a flourishing sawmill site. Some of the machinery and remnant hoop-pine plantation remain. Feel the tingling chill of rainforest shade as you wander along one of five walking tracks—the Rainforest circuit, Cypress Grove track, Western Window track, Greenes Falls track and Westside track all accessible from this site.
