Sunday, September 8th is rapidly approaching, and I am really looking forward to it. For one thing, it's the Lord's Day. We will gather to worship our glorious Savior Jesus Christ. It's also the launch date for G-Groups.

What are G-Groups? They are intergenerational discipleship groups with two main purposes. First, G-Groups are designed to help us grow in our relationship with Jesus Christ. Group members will have the opportunity to grow through personal Bible reading,

group discussion, and regular encouragement to share Christ with others and to invite them to church. Second, G-Groups are designed to help us grow in our relationships with one another. FBC Paris is a multigenerational congregation, but sometimes it's hard to get to know people who are not from our generation. With multiple generations represented in each group, G-Groups are an effort to help us bridge this gap.

Together, group members will be working through the ESV Daily Reading Bible. Each day this Bible reading plan includes a 2 to 3 paragraph explanation of the reading right before the Bible passage and a reflection question right after the passage. The reading plan along with the reflection questions will form the basis of the discussion in the weekly G-Group meetings. This reading plan will take us through the entirety of the Bible over the span of two years.

Group leaders are in place, but there is still time for you to sign up to be part of a group. You can sign up on the sign-up sheet on the Opportunity Board in the church foyer or you can see me and I will help you get connected with a group. Join us as we deepen our walk with Christ and strengthen our bond with one another.


