Véronique Reymond: 'Women were very much in the shadow of men for so many years, centuries. And it's still in our sense, somehow. In our movies, we like to investigate the theme of feminism by looking at intimate relationships between men and women. In My Little Sister, Lisa at first seems a little self-effacing, mostly focussing on her brother and her family. Her inner strength is growing as the film progresses, through the ordeals she has to face. But initially, she is the wife of a successful man and has given up on her career to look after their children. Lots of women have excellent credentials but decide to put their career aspirations aside to allow their partners to thrive professionally.'
