2<sup>nd</sup> PD – 1001 – 2000 Hours

3<sup>rd</sup> PD – 2001 – 3500 Hours

## 3<sup>rd</sup> Year – Apprentice Scale

1<sup>st</sup> PD – 0-1000 Hours

2<sup>nd</sup> PD – 1001 – 2000 Hours

3<sup>rd</sup> PD – 2001 – 3500 Hours

4<sup>th</sup> PD – 3501 – 5000 Hours

## 4<sup>th</sup> Year – Apprentice Scale

1<sup>st</sup> PD – 0-1000 Hours

2<sup>nd</sup> PD – 1001 – 2000 Hours

3<sup>rd</sup> PD – 2001 – 3500 Hours

4<sup>th</sup> PD – 3501 – 5000 Hours

5<sup>th</sup> PD – 5001- 6500 Hours

## 5<sup>th</sup> Year – Apprentice Scale

1<sup>st</sup> PD – 0-1000 Hours

2<sup>nd</sup> PD – 1001 – 2000 Hours

3<sup>rd</sup> PD – 2001 – 3500 Hours

4<sup>th</sup> PD – 3501 – 5000 Hours

5<sup>th</sup> PD – 5001- 6500 Hours

6<sup>th</sup> PD – 6501 – 8000 hours

1. Raises are only presented to committee once per month. You will not see your raise until after committee meeting. Usually they are sent to your contractor within the week which may or may not let them be on your next check depending on their payrolls
2. You MUST have all time cards, fees and paperwork into the office to be eligible. Otherwise you will not get your raise!
3. You must have both classroom hours and OJT hours to qualify for some levels.
4. The committee can and will fine you OJT hours if you do not keep your time cards and paperwork up to date.
