Training Tools/Methods

Training Tools

We are balanced trainers and use balanced training methods and tools to teach dogs. We use various training tools such as prong collars, e-collars, clickers, treats, and toys. The way we pick which one we will need to use and how we should use them depends on the client's dog and what goal we are trying to accomplish.

Training Methods

We use all quadrants of operation such as positive reinforcement, negative reinforcement, positive punishment, and negative punishment. Depending on the dog's training plan will show us which quadrant we will need while training. Treats will be used throughout the training process along with corrections for any undesired behavior. One of the most important things to us here is the relationship between the trainer and the dog. We want training to be a positive experience for everyone including the dog, trainer, and parents.

Private lessons

One-on-one training sessions with you and your dog and get individualized training plans. These lessons will contain the four quadrants of operation (positive reinforcement, negative

reinforcement, positive punishment, and negative punishment). Training tools and reinforcement will be used during the training sessions.

Group classes

Group classes will be offered once a week. There will be more than one dog or person that attends these classes. Please do not bring any reactive dogs to our group classes. We are not liable for any damages or injuries to you, your property, or your dog. Training tools and reinforcement will be used throughout the class. Group classes will get cheaper the more people sign up after the prior five people have signed up for the class. You must keep at least a four-foot minimum radius between you and the dogs around you. We do require you to bring a dog bowl for water and water just in case we do not have one on hand. We are excited to seeing you at our group class!

Training Tools Needed For Training

We require you to bring all of the things necessary for training when you arrive for your scheduled training session. If you need to purchase training tools we will have them available for you to purchase, unless we are out of stock. We only allow certain training tools while training and some tools will not be accepted to be used while working with us.

- At least a four-foot leash
- Prong collar
- Collar
- Some type of containment form ie. car/truck, crate etc.

Tools Not Accepted

- Harnesses of any type
- Halti or face halter or any kind
- Choke chains

Policies

Ages/breeds

- Dogs have to be 6 months old or older to keep for a board and train
- No puppies or dogs allowed to train with us that do not have all their vaccinations
- All breeds are accepted

Vaccines

- Vaccines required are DHPP, Rabies, and Bordetella
- Please bring your vaccination records for ages of dogs
- You need to have a copy of all vaccines before class starts.
- Titers test is not accepted.

Unaltered dogs

- Unaltered dogs are allowed
- Females in season are not allowed for group classes but are allowed for private lessons

Rescheduling

• Your deposit is nonrefundable

Payment Methods

- Deposit is required and non-refundable

- We require you to bring all of your own equipment needed for training
- We do not guarantee any training

- We will not be responsible for any property that gets dirty, damaged, or injured

- We accept blind, handicapped, amputated, deaf, and special needs dogs
- We do not allow group playtimes
- All dogs must be on a leash when arriving until the time of leaving unless otherwise stated
- We are not liable or responsible for any lose or lost dogs
- We are not liable for any health conditions of your dog/dogs
- We are not liable for any injury to your dog/dogs
- If there is proof of negligence or abuse by anyone it will be reported

- You are liable for any dog bites to staff, clients, or other animals
- You will not get a certificate if you do not complete the program you signed up for.
- You will not get a certificate if you do not pass the class.
- We are allowed to take pictures and videos and use them for marketing and promotional purposes.
