

## **ProCare App: Parent Communication Tool**



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Billing Details: All registered campers were required to submit the Registration Form that is our billing schedule per student. Tuition is based on weekly enrollment billed monthly.

Invoices are sent on the first (1st) of each month, and due by the fifth (5th). Accounts past due will result in termination of Admissions Agreement and withdrawal of the camper.

Changes to enrollment require a minimum two-week notice to avoid to avoid fees. Tuition is not credited or refunded for sick, holiday, or missed days.

What to bring ...

## **SAFTEY & SUPERVISION**

Always drop-off your child in the care of a supervising WVCA Cougar Club Teacher with visual and verbal acknowledgment that your child has been received into care.

Also provide verbal and visual communication with staff at pick-up.

All campers must be signed-in and —out of care. Campers will only be released to adults 18 years and older on the emergency contact list with valid ID.



## Sunscreen Policy:

Families are responsible for applying sunscreen before drop-off in the mornings to camp.

Campers will re-apply in the afternoon after our rest period.

Sunscreen <u>must</u> be checked into the office and permission slip signed to apply.

## **Walking Field Trips**

We will be attending multiple walking field trips. In order to attend walking trips, campers must be in good behavioral standing, and have general pedestrian safety knowledge. Field trip ratios shift from 1:14 to 1:10.

We highly encourage parent participation for incoming Kindergarteners, and students who have not been on trips before.
