




Introduction Details for a Successful Summer

Welcome to WVCA Cougar Club Summer Camp 2022. We are a licensed school aged child care program, and are committed to providing our students with quality care with an authentic summer camp experience. Please review these details to ensure you are informed, and set for a successful summer.

Please make sure to review the WVCA Cougar Club Parent Handbook for program hours, daily schedule, what to bring, and, specific details regarding our program policies, and procedures. As a licensed child care, there are some very important details that differ from your student's school day experience while in our care. ProCare: Parent Communication Tool & Sign-in/out Tablet

We utilize ProCare, our parent communication app for your phone. Once your student has been enrolled, you'll receive an email invitation to download the app, and create your parent profile. We use this app to communicate general "happenings", accidents, injuries, photos, and provides you a direct link to your child's child care teacher. Make sure to download the app within 10 days of the invitation before it expires. We also use ProCare app on our sign-in and -out tablet located in the WVCA Main Lobby.



Cougar Club campus location for drop-off and pick-up is posted on the Cougar Club Door.

We will only release students to identified emergency contact people who are 18 years and older, and have provided proof of identification.

All campers must be signed-in by 9:30 AM to participate for the day.

Billing Details

Tuition is based on weekly enrollment, and billed monthly. All Cougar Summer Camp families will receive an email invoice on the first of each month. Tuition is due on the 1st, late on the 5th.
