Summer and School Closure Camps

Cougar Club Summer Camp and School Closure Camps provides a camp atmosphere with weekly themes and daily activities that include Rallies, Dress-up Days, Water Play Days, Creative Art, Bible Lessons, onsite special events, and walking field trips.

Before & After School Care

WVCA Cougar Club before and after school care provides child care onsite exclusively to WVCA students including breakfast and an afternoon snack. Students will be in the care of fully qualified licensed teachers who will provide an authentic childhood before and after school experience with outdoor play, organized sports and activities, creative art, and homework support in the afternoons. Students are escorted to school, and supervised to the care of Cougar Club afterschool.

Cougar Club Distance Social and Creative Activities

WVCA Cougar Club enrolled students will automatically be provided Activity Kits for at home creative arts and mental health activities in response to school closure from COVID-19.

- Activity Kits with materials for non-academic creative fun with an emphasis on mental health activities as recommended by the CDC provided every two weeks/twice a month.
- Weekly Zoom for social interaction with a Cougar Club teacher supervising content with games and activities.
- Tuition Rate for Distance Social and Creative Activities \$100 per month.
- Will be automatically enrolled if program is required to close for two or more weeks.
- Families may opt-out within 3 business days of closure.

COVID-19 Financial Policy
Due to the current global pandemic of COVID-19 and all curriculum materials and supplies required to meet current regulations that are purchased and provided at time of enrollment, first month tuition is non-refundable. initial
In the event of a closure due to COVID-19 regulations Tuition payed will be credited towards accounts for future care or <i>Cougar Club Distance Social and Creative Activities</i> , but will not be refunded due to services prepared and purchased at time of enrollment. Children will automatically be enrolled in <i>Cougar Club Distance Social and Creative Activities</i> if the center is required to be closed for two or more weeks. Families who do not want to participate must opt-out in writing within 3 business days or their account will be charged the Distance Social and Creative Activities fee of \$100 per monthinitial
Payment Options
New and enrolled families will receive a monthly invoice. Payments are due on the first (1^{st}) of each month, and late on the third (3^{rd}) of each month. The following payment options are available:

Accounts are due on the first (1st) of each month whether or not a courtesy statement is received, and late on the third (3rd) of each month which a \$50.00 late fee will be charged.
