

Please Report the Following Spills or Releases to the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment's Emergency and Incident Reporting Line

To make a report (24/7), use the Reporting Form or call 1-877-518-5608

If this is an immediate emergency, please call 911.

Reportable Issues:

- Greater than 25 gallons of any Petroleum Product released to ground only
- Any releases to waterways (i.e. storm sewer, creeks, river, lakes, dry waterways)
- All mercury spills and all asbestos releases that meet the reportable quantity
- All sanitary sewer releases
- Any deliberate releases (i.e. dumping, burying, etc.)
- All releases of chemicals that eclipse the reportable quantities detailed in EPA's List of Lists
- Permit exceedances

If it is after hours, and not an emergency, you may leave a message on the voicemail. If it is an after-hours environmental emergency, please call 1-877-518-5608, and if the phone is not answered, call the duty officer listed on the voicemail.

If you have an incident to report that does not meet these qualifications, you may want to call your county health department. Building issues with mold or pests, or other habitability issues, as well as any restaurant concerns would be handled by the county health department.
