Safety Support Center

The IWS Safety Support Center is available to all employees across the organization, including office personnel, fabrication, manufacturing, product services, engineering, and construction teams.

This site should be your primary starting point if something goes wrong or if you are unsure how to respond to a safety related situation.

If you experience a minor injury, such as a small puncture wound or a cut to the hand, the injury must be reported in accordance with company procedures. The Safety Support Center homepage provides clear instructions on how to respond to any type of incident, including how to contact the injury management team using the toll-free reporting number.

Under the Safety dropdown tab, the “Emergencies” section provides:

- Driving directions to all IWS offices, facilities, and projects
- Driving directions to approved injury care facilities and hospitals
- Emergency Action Plans for all offices, projects, and facilities

The Safety tab also includes important resources that apply to all employees:

- Incident Notification form
- OSHA and labor law posters for federal and state requirements
- OSHA 300A logs
- Permits and procedures
- Safety alerts
- Safety Data Sheets for chemicals used in all workplaces, including offices
- Insurance certificates for company owned vehicles
- Company safety scorecard, updated weekly

Under the Procurement tab, employees may order personal protective equipment for field visits or report hazardous conditions that need to be corrected.

Employees are encouraged to become familiar with the Safety Support Center before an incident occurs. Knowing where to go and what to do is one of the simplest and most effective ways to prevent injuries and respond appropriately when something does happen.
