### **Group Trail Riding Rules**

- 1) Each ride will have a designated Ride Leader, and one (1) Drag Rider. Stay with the group, behind the Ride Leader and in front of the Drag Rider at all times
- 2) Keep your horse at least one (1) horse length behind the horse in front of you. Known kickers should have a red ribbon tied to the horse's tail.
- 3) If the need to stop anywhere on the trail, inform the Ride Leader/Drag Leader. The Ride Leader will stop at a safe point for all riders. The Ride Leader will decide when the rider/s are ready to safely start the ride.
- 4) In the event a rider must leave the group, they must inform the Ride Leader, another rider will accompany the rider, unless the rider declines the escort, the rider will be considered not part of the trail ride.
- 5) No dogs are allowed on the trails. Dogs in camp must be kept on a leash, kept tied or confined. Under no circumstances shall a dog be permitted around get togethers such as Potluck Dinners, or where food is being served.
- 6) No alcoholic drinks on the trail ride.
- 7) No horses/mules shall be ponied.
- 8) Riders in possession of firearms are permitted and encouraged on all trail rides. All Federal, State and Local Laws will apply.
- 10) Riding side by side is permitted when the trail allows. Safety first.
- 11) Saddles are required on all rides. No bareback or bareback pads will be permitted.
- 12) When passing another rider, tell the rider your intentions that you are going Pass. When passing the rider, do so at a slightly faster walk.
- 13) No stallions are not permitted on any Glendale Equestrian Rides.
- 14) All riders under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian over the age of 18.
- 15) Please do not litter on the trail. Take out what you bring in.
