Dear President Trump,

The Montrose County Board of County Commissioners writes you today with the utmost urgency and profound commitment to defend the Constitution of the United States. We are witnessing, firsthand, the rapid decline of Constitutional Governance within the State of Colorado.

Through a relentless wave of unconstitutional state legislation and government overreach, the Great State of Colorado is stripping it's citizens of rights once secured under the Constitution. - To review Colorado's legislation that violates rights guaranteed by the Constitution.

- To support rural counties and local governments committed to preserving and defending the United States Constitution.

We are calling upon the Federal Government, as guardians of the Constitution, to step forward and defend the People of Colorado against their own State Government's unlawful actions. When a state violates the fundamental rights of it's citizens, it becomes the solemn duty of the nation to intervene and restore Constitutional order.
