

Goods from the Woods

Students will discover that many items that we use every day are actually products derived from trees.

4) Tape a picture of a tree product to each student's back. Tell students they must figure out the product on their back by asking each other "yes" or "no" questions. For example, "Is this product used in our school?"

Materials needed:

- Pictures of wood by-products
- Cardstock



Mount pictures of each item to cardstock. Place the stack of pictures upside down on a desk or table. Have the kids choose one and hold it to their foreheads without peeking at it. They will ask their classmates 10 yes or no questions about the products to determine what they were holding.







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
