In the CCEI initiative, we are building upon existing, proven, evidence-based strategies, and improving them with clearly defined goals, outcomes, and measurements so we can better monitor our progress and continue to improve upon it.

CREER believes that education is the key that will open the door to a better future for our children and their families. Our educational programs help close the academic and cultural gaps that poverty creates. In 2024, and thanks to our community partner OCASA College Prep, we continued our educational programs by implementing a small CREER Summer session with 52 children (288 spots), fifteen high-school and Junior high-school volunteers, and six educators.

100% of the students who attended these programs were given full scholarships. In addition to the 2024 CREER Summer Programs and thanks to the close and long partnership with Emerald Day Cove Summer Programs and Rockstar Ministries' generosity we were able to send 45 CREER students to a one-week summer session on full scholarships, a \$750 dollar value per child.

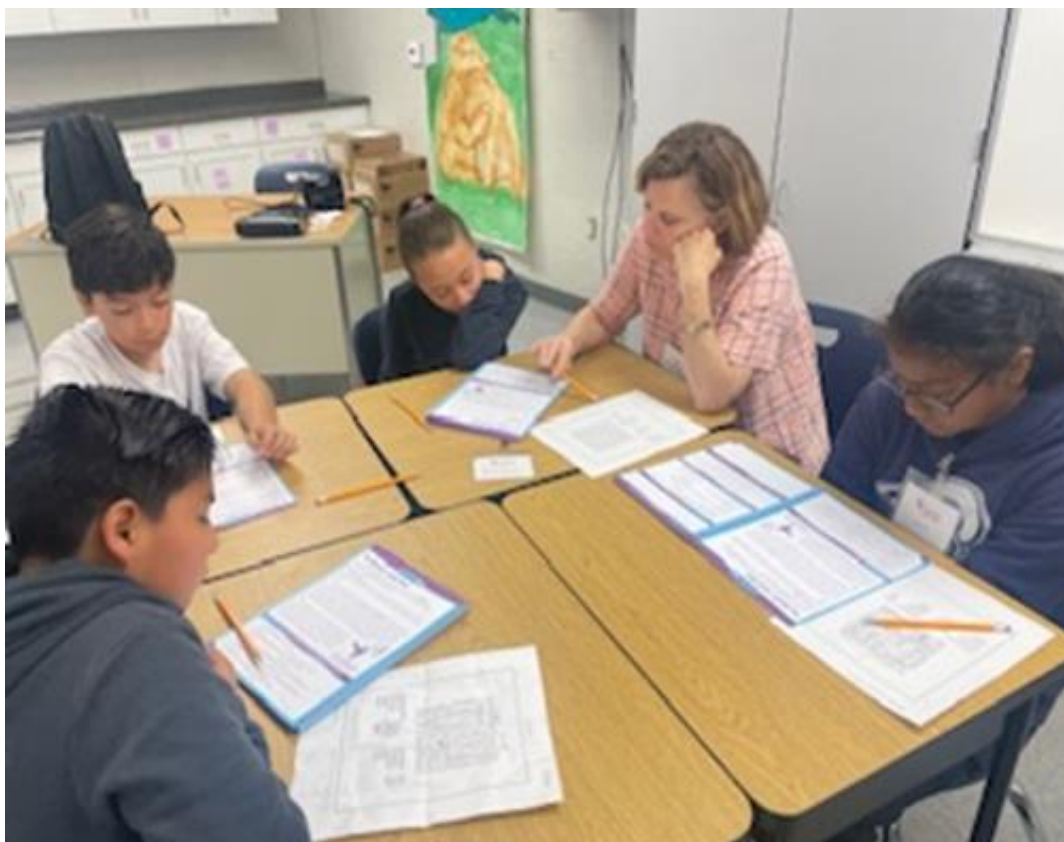

CREER Food & Diaper Distribution

The CREER Food Pantry has completed 240 weeks (56 Months) of food and diaper distribution to families affected economically by the COVID-19 pandemic and its aftermath. By Tuesday, November 26th, 2024, we have distributed more than 4,028 pallets, 185,285 boxes/bags of food, 237 pallets of diapers, and more than \$185,752.00 in emergency funds and goods. The food boxes represent 741,148 meals distributed in 56 months.

In the last 240 weeks, the average number of families served is 122,222 with an average of 4 individuals per family, the average number of people served by the pantry is 488,888. Also, we distributed more than 900 Christmas Presents to families in OC. The CREER Food and Diaper Distribution operates without interruptions on a bi-weekly basis.

In addition to our educational and food distribution programs, CREER is also a vital source of information, advocacy, mentoring, and resource channeling to the CREER families. In recent months and in partnership with Families Together, we have been providing access to Dental & Vision services to more than 338 patients in Mobil Clinics out of our parking lot.

CREER, in coordination with The Outreach Program Services of America and the Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP), distributed more than 1,275 tablets and phones to the most vulnerable members of our community.

Also, CREER and thanks to our partnerships with EDISON International and SDG&E have connected hundreds of qualifying families to the CARE, FERA, and Medical Baseline Programs. Families enrolled in the CARE Program are eligible to receive a 30% Discount on their electricity and gas bills.

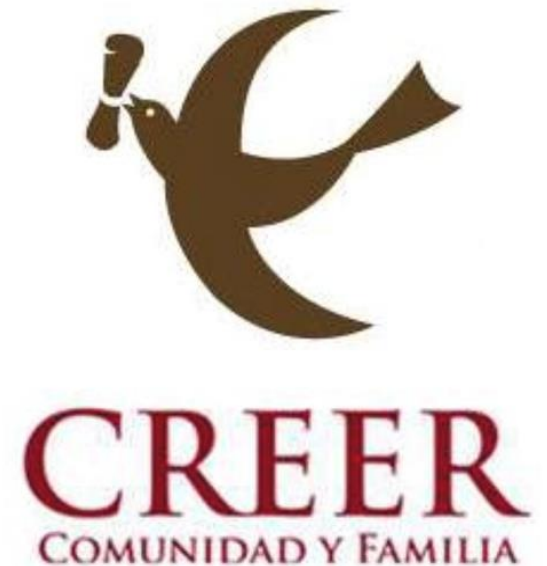
