being first duly sworn to tell the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth, was examined and testified as follows:

EXAMINATION

BY MS. SUMNER:

Q Please state your name for the record.

A Angel Brooks.

Q Angel, what's your date of birth?

A 10-29-82.

Q And as you've found out earlier, my name is Stacey Sumner. Present with us is Detective Stephen Foshey and Detective Michael Jenkins with the Sheriff's Office. You've come to them at some point with some information regarding a double homicide that occurred in Trilby; is that correct?

A Yes, ma'am.

Q Okay. Do you recall when you came forward and spoke with Detective Foshey and Detective Jenkins?

A No, I don't.

Q Do you know Luc Pierre Charles? That's L-u-c P-i-e-r-r-e, last name Charles, common spelling.

A Yes.

Q How do you know him?

A I met him through Jeremy.

1 Q And Jeremy you're discussing is Jeremy Henry?

2 A Uh-huh.

3 Q How do you know Jeremy?

4 A He was my boyfriend.

5 Q How long was he your boyfriend?

6 A Three years.

7 Q Do you know Andre Pierre Charles?

8 A Yes.

9 Q And how is he related to Luc?

10 A That's his brother.

11 Q Okay. What about Tyree Jenkins? Do you know  
12 Tyree Jenkins?

13 A Yes.

14 Q How did you know him?

15 A A friend of Jeremy's.

16 Q Do you recall the events -- and I think you  
17 had indicated it was a Thursday in late July. Do you  
18 remember some things happening?

19 A Yes, ma'am.

20 Q Okay. Where were you on Thursday and we're  
21 gonna call it July 27th of 2006?

22 A In Pasco Woods.

23 Q What were you doing in Pasco Woods?

24 A Baby-sitting.

25 Q Okay. Who were you baby-sitting for?

1 A Jessica Vazquez.

2 Q How long had you know Jessica?

3 A About a week.

4 Q Okay. Where did Luc and Andre live?

5 A Downstairs.

6 Q At Pasco Woods?

7 A Yes.

8 Q This is an apartment complex in the  
9 Wesley Chapel area?

10 A Yes.

11 Q Okay. Is it kind of off I forget the name of  
12 that road there but by the Outback?

13 A Yes.

14 Q And there is a church near it?

15 A Yes.

16 Q And do you recall seeing Luc, Andre and Jeremy  
17 on that day and Tyree on that day?

18 A Yes.

19 Q What were you all doing?

20 A Just hanging out.

21 Q Okay. Was there anybody else with you?

22 A No.

23 Q Okay. What time of the day are we talking,  
24 daytime, nighttime?

25 A Daytime.

1 Q Did there come a time when you saw Luc in a  
2 vehicle?

3 A Yes.

4 Q Who was he with?

5 A Tyree Jenkins and two other boys.

6 Q Can you describe the vehicle for us?

7 A A green four-door car.

8 Q And when you saw him driving the vehicle, was  
9 it dark time?

10 A Yes.

11 Q Do you think it was close to midnight?

12 A Close to or a little bit after.

13 Q Okay. Who else was in the vehicle with them?

14 A Two white boys.

15 Q Okay. Had you seen them before?

16 A No.

17 Q Were you in a position where you could see the  
18 description of them other than being white boys?

19 A No.

20 Q When you say "boys," could you give us an age  
21 frame on them?

22 A Nope.

23 Q Just could tell they were males?

24 A Uh-huh.

25 Q That's a yes?

1 A Yes.

2 Q Okay. Did you have any contact with a girl  
3 named Farah?

4 A Yes.

5 Q Where was she?

6 A On the other side of the complex.

7 Q Okay. Did she come over by where you were in  
8 this apartment you were in?

9 A I walked to where she was.

10 Q Okay. You were outside walking around?

11 A Yes.

12 Q And Jessica had already returned home from  
13 work?

14 A Yes.

15 Q What time would she normally work?

16 A From like 7 in the morning till like 6:30,  
17 7:00 at night.

18 Q So your baby-sitting duties were over?

19 A Yes.

20 Q Whose apartment were you hanging out in those  
21 later late night hours?

22 A Jessica's.

23 Q And that's where Luc and Andre, Tyree and  
24 Jeremy were also?

25 A Yes, and in and out.

1 Q In and out, okay. Now, had you been drinking?

2 A No.

3 Q Taking any drugs?

4 A No.

5 Q When you say you went to another spot, is  
6 there like a common area with this apartment complex?

7 A Nope.

8 Q I mean, when you say the other side of the  
9 complex, what drew your attention over there?

10 A Because that's where the direction the green  
11 car come from.

12 Q Okay. So you had walked over that way?

13 A Yes.

14 Q And did you have a conversation with this  
15 girl?

16 A Yes.

17 Q What did she say to you?

18 A I asked her her name, and she told me, and she  
19 just told me that she was looking for Ray.

20 Q Okay. Did you know who Ray was?

21 A Nope.

22 Q Did she appear to be under the influence of  
23 anything?

24 A Yes.

25 Q What made you think she was under the



1 influence?

2 A She said she had taken some Xanaxes.

3 Q And you knew what those were?

4 A Uh-huh.

5 Q Controlled substance?

6 A Yes.

7 Q Were you able to aid her in finding this Ray  
8 person she was looking for?

9 A Nope.

10 Q What's the next thing that you did?

11 A We got in a vehicle, a black --

12 Q Did you go back up to Jessica's apartment?

13 A Oh, yes.

14 Q Now, how many floors are in this apartment  
15 building?

16 A Two.

17 Q Two, okay. And you're in the apartment.

18 Who's present there?

19 A At that point nobody.

20 Q Okay. Well, at some point were you with Andre  
21 and Jeremy?

22 A Yes.

23 Q Did Andre receive a telephone call?

24 A Yes, ma'am.

25 Q Do you recall what time of the night that was?

1 A I know it was after midnight.

2 Q Okay. And did you overhear the conversation?

3 A Yes.

4 Q And what was the conversation?

5 A Luc wants us to bring him the girl.

6 Q Let me back up. Did you overhear who was on  
7 the phone?

8 A No.

9 Q It was Andre's cell phone that rang?

10 A Yes.

11 Q And when Andre got off the phone, he made some  
12 statements?

13 A Yes.

14 Q Okay. And what was it that he said?

15 A Luc wants us to bring him the girl.

16 Q Did you know who he was talking about?

17 A No.

18 Q Based upon what Andre said, did you have an  
19 idea who was on the other end of that phone call?

20 A Yes.

21 Q Who?

22 A Luc.

23 Q Okay. And after he said, "Luc wants us to  
24 bring him the girl," were there any other things that  
25 Andre said?

1 A Yeah. He said Peepers was gone.

2 Q Okay. Did he say anything else?

3 A No.

4 Q Did he make a comment about what was done, if  
5 it was smart, stupid, what?

6 A Yeah, he said they had did something stupid.

7 Q When he said "they had did something stupid,"  
8 who did you take that to mean?

9 A Tyree and Luc.

10 Q And after finding out that Luc wanted you all  
11 to bring him the girl, what happened?

12 A They said they were gonna take her to Meadow  
13 Pointe.

14 Q They being?

15 A Jeremy and Andre.

16 Q Okay. And did you go with them?

17 A No.

18 Q Did you get in the car with them?

19 A Yes. I went to the 7-Eleven.

20 Q Okay. And you're talking about 7-Eleven at  
21 Old Pasco and 54?

22 A Yes.

23 Q And did you go inside?

24 A Yes.

25 Q Did anybody else go inside with you?

1 A No.

2 Q Okay. What happened after you got out of  
3 7-Eleven?

4 A Went back to the house and they dropped me off  
5 and they left.

6 Q Okay. And do you know where they went?

7 A They said they were going to Meadow Pointe.

8 Q How long were they gone?

9 A About a hour.

10 Q Okay. When they came back, who was with them?

11 A Nobody.

12 Q Okay. So Jeremy and Andre came back?

13 A Yes.

14 Q Whose car were they driving?

15 A Jessica Valazquez.

16 Q Okay. And what kind of car was that?

17 A A black Blazer.

18 Q Okay. And what time do you think it was when  
19 they came back?

20 A I don't know. It had to be at least 6:30,  
21 7:00.

22 Q What makes you think that?

23 A 'Cause it was daylight.

24 Q Okay. And what happened when they came back?

25 A Nothing. Jessica got up, and she took us to

1 Jessica Rotolo's house.

2 MS. SUMNER: And is it R-o-t-o-l-o?

3 DETECTIVE FOSHEY: Yes.

4 Q (By Ms. Sumner) And where did Jessica live?

5 A Zephyrhills.

6 Q When you got to Jessica's house, what did you

7 all do?

8 A Stayed there for a few minutes and got her car

9 and went to Dade City.

10 Q What kind of car does she have?

11 A A white Corolla.

12 Q Who was driving then?

13 A I was.

14 Q So who went with you to Dade City?

15 A Jeremy and Andre.

16 Q Whose home did you go to in Dade City?

17 A Whose what?

18 Q Whose home?

19 A Jamal.

20 Q Is that Jamal Sampson?

21 A I guess that's his last name.

22 Q Okay. Black male?

23 A Yes.

24 Q Do you know about how old he is?

25 A Probably about 17.

1 Q Do you know where he lived, what area?

2 A In Cash Quarters.

3 Q And that's gonna be east of the railroad  
4 tracks over here behind the courthouse somewhere?

5 A Yes.

6 Q Okay. Who was there when you got to Jamal's  
7 house?

8 A Just Jamal, Tyree, Luc and some other fellow.

9 Q Some unknown black male?

10 A Uh-huh.

11 Q What kind of cars were out in front of that  
12 residence?

13 A There was a green Mazda 66.

14 Q And you said this is a -- or you didn't say.  
15 What type of place was this?

16 A An apartment complex.

17 Q Okay. When you got inside, what happened?

18 A Jeremy, Luc, Tyree and Andre went into the  
19 room.

20 Q Into a room without you?

21 A Yes.

22 Q Where was Jamal?

23 A Laying on the sofa.

24 Q Okay. Where was this unknown black male?

25 A I guess he was in the room with them.

1 Q Okay. How long were they in the room?

2 A About 30 minutes to a hour.

3 Q Where were you during this time?

4 A Sitting in the kitchen.

5 Q Where were you when they came out?

6 A Sitting in the kitchen.

7 Q Were they talking about anything when they

8 came out of the room?

9 A Yes.

10 Q What were they saying?

11 A Luc came out of the room, and he had a gun in

12 his hand.

13 Q Had you seen Luc with a gun previously?

14 A Yes.

15 Q Same type of gun or different guns?

16 A It was a automatic. That's all I know.

17 Q What did it look like?

18 A It was black.

19 Q What type of clip did it have?

20 A I don't know.

21 Q Did it look like a large clip?

22 A Yes.

23 Q So it hung out down under his hand?

24 A Yes.

25 Q What was he doing with the gun?

1 A Making hand motions.

2 Q Okay. What do you mean making hand motions?

3 A Towards the ground like he was shooting at  
4 somebody.

5 Q Okay. What was he saying?

6 A "They were begging for their life and I told  
7 them to pray."

8 Q Okay. And then what did he say?

9 A "I told them to pray now, and I emptied out my  
10 whole clip."

11 Q Did you know what he was talking about?

12 A Nope.

13 Q What was Tyree doing?

14 A He was laughing.

15 Q What was Jeremy doing?

16 A Telling them they were stupid.

17 Q Okay. Did there come a time when you heard  
18 about a homicide that occurred in Trilby?

19 A Yes.

20 Q When was that?

21 A The same day on the news.

22 Q Okay. At some point did you hear the name  
23 Peepers as being one of the victims in that homicide?

24 A A couple days later.

25 Q Okay. And after hearing that and hearing Luc



1 talk about this and hearing Andre's comments that Luc  
2 made, what did you think happened?

3 A That somehow that they killed them.

4 Q They being?

5 A Tyree and Luc.

6 Q Okay. Had killed these two boys?

7 A Yes.

8 Q Now, did Jeremy Henry and you discuss these  
9 murders?

10 A No.

11 Q Did you ever hear Jeremy discussing these  
12 murders with either Luc or Tyree?

13 A No.

14 Q Were you aware that Jeremy Henry was a person  
15 of interest in this case?

16 A Yes.

17 Q How did you become aware of that?

18 A The news, newspaper.

19 Q Okay. And did you ever hear Jeremy talking  
20 about that?

21 A Yes.

22 Q Who was he talking about that with?

23 A His cousin on the phone.

24 Q And that being?

25 A Janelle Harrison.

1 Q Janelle Harrison. What did he tell Janelle?

2 A That Luc or Tyree needs to come forth and tell  
3 what really happened, tell them that he didn't have  
4 anything to do with it or he was gonna call someone and  
5 tell them the real story.

6 Q Okay. And the real story being what you've  
7 just told us?

8 A Yes.

9 Q And did Janelle Harrison have some kind of  
10 relationship with Luc Pierre Charles?

11 A She did.

12 Q What was the relationship?

13 A She was his girlfriend.

14 Q To your knowledge, did she ever get into  
15 contact with Luc?

16 A No.

17 Q Did Jeremy Henry ever get in contact with  
18 Luc --

19 A Nope.

20 Q -- to tell him to come forward?

21 A No.

22 Q Okay. Are you aware of some conversation that  
23 happened wherein Luc said he was gonna come forward and  
24 set everybody straight?

25 A Yeah. Like a couple days later Janelle called

1 and told him that he said he was gonna come forth but  
2 like a day later he was gone.

3 Q Now, we're using "he."

4 A Luc.

5 Q So Janelle called Jeremy and you overheard  
6 this conversation?

7 A Yes.

8 Q Okay. And Janelle told Jeremy that Luc said  
9 he was gonna come forward?

10 A Yes.

11 Q But you later heard that Luc left town?

12 A Yes.

13 Q Do you know where he might be?

14 A Last time I heard he was in Georgia.

15 Q You have no idea where?

16 A Nope.

17 Q Anything else? Okay.

18 (Off-the-record discussion.)

19 Q (By Ms. Sumner) Nobody's promised you  
20 anything --

21 A No.

22 Q -- to come forward? Threaten you in any way  
23 to come forward?

24 A No.

25 Q You've been placed under oath. Everything

1 you've told us has been the truth?

2 A Yes.

3 Q And you've gotten no promises for any of this  
4 testimony; right?

5 A Nope.

6 MS. SUMNER: Okay. That's it.



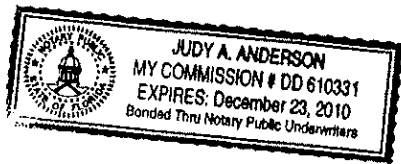


